#### **Family Movie Nights Conclude with *Beauty and the Beast* This Friday at the Palmdale Amphitheater**

PALMDALE – The popular animated Disney animatic classic *Beauty and the Beast* will be shown this Friday evening Aug. 11 at City of Palmdale’s popular Family Movie Nights at the Palmdale Amphitheater, located at 2723 Rancho Vista Blvd.

In the 1991 animated classic, Disney’s *Beauty and the Beast* tells the tale of an arrogant young prince is turned into a hideous Beast by a wicked enchantress until he learns to love and be loved in return. The spirited, headstrong village girl Belle (Paige O’Hara) enters the Beast’s castle after he imprisons her father Maurice (Rex Everhart). With the help of his enchanted servants, including the matronly Mrs. Potts, Belle begins to draw the cold-hearted Beast out of his isolation. It stars the voices of Robby Benson, Paige O’Hara, Rex Everhart and Angela Lansbury.
